ENTITY CONSENT TO DISCLOSURE OF TAX INFORMATION
TO THIRD PARTY TAX RETURN PREPARERS

Federal law requires that this consent form be provided to you. Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return, and in certain limited circumstance, for purposes of involving tax return preparation. If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form. Because our ability to disclose your tax return information to another tax return preparer affects the service that we provide to you and its cost, we may decline to provide you with service or change the terms of service that we provide to you if you do not sign the form. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.

This consent will be valid for a period of ten years beginning on the date this consent is signed. This consent can be withdrawn at any time during the consent period.

We understand we have the right to limit the consent to specific information, rather than the disclosure of the entire return. Recognizing that right, we consent to the disclosure of the entire tax return. However, we have the ability to request a more limited disclosure of tax return information as may be directed in the future.
